## #4 Prince of Peace (Omnificence)

Isaiah 9:6

Wonderful Counselor - Omniscient –wisdom – seek Him

He knows us, our needs and can miraculously change us

Mighty God – Omnipotent – power - worship Him

He is able forgive our sins and give us new life

Everlasting Father – Omnipresent – love – Follow Him

The Lord is ever-present and ever loving.

Prince of Peace – the One who can create and sustain peace in us

The Triumph – Christ in you.

### How to receive the peace

1. Restoration - Seek peace with God first

Peace with others and yourself come later

Definition of peace – Spiritual harmony through restoration with God

2. Reset of Mind

Philippians 4:6-7 **Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.**

Colossians 3:15 **Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.**

3. Rest

2 Thessalonians 3:16 **Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times and in every way. The Lord be with all of you.**

4. Rejoice

2 Corinthians 13:11 **Dear brothers and sisters, I close my letter with these last words: Be joyful. Grow to maturity. Encourage each other. Live in harmony and peace. Then the God of love and peace will be with you.**
