Ephesians 6:10-20

Guilt, Shame and Fear Cultures

-The world cultures divided into these major categories

Fear / Power describes animistic cultures where people afraid of evil and harm pursue power over the spirit world through magical rituals. Today they are dismissed as superstitions but at the same time embraced by media and most people. They believe that the world is filled with visible and invisible forces to be feared. There are unseen spirits, demons, and gods that are behind the scenes impacting the seen world

Satan's biggest lie is this - "there is no Satan or demons."

If we believe that: **1. We do not believe the Bible** where Satan is named 36 times and the devil 29 times. Every book of the New Testaments names him. **2. We do not believe in Jesus** who spoke of the devil 25 times and battled him by casting out demons through the power of God

What Fear / Power cultures have right

1. There is an unseen world with God, Satan, heaven and hell
2. There are curses and strongholds that hinder the work of God
3. There is a spiritual war going on in the world today.

What is not necessary for those who believe in the true God

1. To live in fear and uncertainty
2. To seek to appease the spirits
3. To manipulate the spirits to favor us

A. The Call to Stand

Be strong = Basic training in the Lord
Power =strength, muscle, Might =reserve power

B. The Armor

Use the weapons provided
To Stand firm against the schemes (plural) of the enemy
