The Five T's of Stewardship

Talents 1 Peter 4:10

Review – Using what God has given us

Temple – body as home of Holy Spirit

Time – Given by grace to be used for God

I. The Distribution of Talents - <u>Each</u> of you

A. No exceptions - every person

B. No unimportant people in God's Plan I Corinthians 12:7

C. Distributed according to His will not our wish - I Corinthians 12:11

II. The Diversity of Talents

- Use <u>whatever gift</u> you have, -<u>various forms</u> I Corinthians 12:4-6

A. Names – we are including all

Skills, Talents, Abilities, Spiritual Gifts Listed – Romans 12:6-8, I Corinthians 12: 27-30

--- Ephesians 4: 11-12, I Peter 4:10-11

Not listed but implied-Hospitality, prayer, special skills

B. Difference between natural talents and spiritual gifts

Natural – from birth, that which is easy to master

Spiritual – from new birth, that which builds the Kingdom

How do I know what Spiritual Gifts God has given me?

Joy they produce in using, Ease they are to use Fruit they produce – results for the Kingdom

III. The Drive of Talents - to serve others

Serve - Diakoneo - same verb as serving tables, preparing food

A. The Purpose of talents and gifts

- 1. For the common good I Corinthians 12:7
- 2. To build up others I Corinthians 14:12
- 3. To equip others for service Ephesians 4:12
- 4. To allow us to do our part in the body Ephesians 4:16

B. The Standard of service

1. Love - I Corinthians 13:1-3

2. Glorify God - not me.

IV. The Duty of Talents - as faithful stewards

Steward - one responsible for the management of that which belongs to another - lands, finances, servants, property

A. According to what we received Matthew 25:15

Rewarded according to faithfulness not results

B. Interdependent upon others (Body of Christ) I Corinthians 12:14-21

Eliminates pride - I am better, *Demands cooperation* - I need you *There is no life without diversity*

And no life in one part separately

C. Only one standard - faithfulness

V. The Dynamic of Talents - God's grace

Grace - The favor of God according to His love and mercy All that we do is by the general grace of God - life and breath All we do in the Body of Christ is by the specific grace of God -talents

A. His grace is powerful and complete

Seen in Salvation Ephesians 2:8-9 Accomplished through His Word - in power

B. His grace give us the ability to use the talents we have

2 Timothy 1:6-7 a spirit of power, love and self-discipline

What is our part?

- 1. Commitment to Christ as Lord of every part of your life No exceptions - No reservations
- 2. Commitment to the Body of Christ the Church When each does his/her part - it is healthy and grows Don't ask what I can get but rather what can I give.

How to discover and use the talents God has given

1. Thankfully acknowledge talents you know and use them

Check your spirit

When other use their talents

Do I rejoice or am I jealous

When others fail to use talents or misuse them

Am I offended or do I reach out in sympathy and care

- 2. Try a variety of ministries to discover new one Ease, Joy and Fruit
- 3. Diligently develop any gift He has given.
