**Christ - condemnation of Greed** 

Luke 12:13-34

Christ was concerned with all mankind. He knew that greed and covetousness destroyed men so He spoke of it often. Luke 6:20, 25; 9:25; Luke 12

He was concerned about the heart - not the pocketbook.

I. The Problem

Luke 12:13-14

Setting - large crown (Luke 12:1). Teaching on Hypocrisy 1-11

Unnamed man spoke up - asking him to settle an inheritance

Christ came as Savior not Judge - Later He will judge

Deeper problem - nothing would satisfy *Greed is unquenchable* 

II. The Principle

Luke 12:15

A. Strong Warning

Beware - believe that danger exists

Danger of wealth - It chokes the Word of God - Matthew 13:22

- It creates snares and temptations - I Timothy 6:10

-It gives false sense of security

Be on your guard - constant vigilance is needed

All kinds of greed - Money, possessions, power, time

Greed = Idolatry Colossians 3:5b Don't be greedy, for a greedy

person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world.

B. Life does not consists of the abundance of one possessions

Who a person is cannot be confused with what he has!

III. The Parable

Luke 12:16-21

A Rich man who was not rich enough

A. What he did right

Good crops = good farmer

Care of crops for preservation

B. What he did wrong

1. He failed to acknowledge all from God

2. He failed to understand the purpose of wealth

To serve God - by serving fellow men

3. He was selfish in his evaluation

11 personal pronouns - I, my

4. He saw security in his possessions

Eat, drink and be merry

Also used by those in despair I Corinthians 15:32

5. He thought he would live long and did not prepare

IV. The Proclamation of Truth

Luke 12:22-34

A. Do not worry

22-30

1. Dangers of worry

a. It is destructive of life

b. It is deceptive - false view of life

c. It is debilitating - Proverbs 22:13 - there is a lion

2. How not to worry

a. Look at the birds

b. Look at your abilities (or lack of them)

c. Look at the flowers

3. Why not to worry

God knows what you really need

B. Seek God's Kingdom (how to be really rich)

31-34

1. Seek His Kingdom

Seek the spiritual benefits of His kingdom Rather than the material goods of the world

2. Be satisfied with what we have

Jesus came to offer us abundant life -am I experiencing it?

No need to fear - God delights to give us the Kingdom *Philippians 4:12, 1 Timothy 6:6* 

3. Sell what you have to able to give

Does this mean sell everything? No - *Acts 2*But from time to time we should sacrifice

4. Set your hearts on heavenly riches 1 Timothy 6:17-19

Do good, be rich in good deeds, Be generous, willing to share

## Questions we should ask ourselves

Do I wish I had the problem the farmer had? - too much?

Do I judge others by what they own?

Do I worry about material things?

Am I storing up my treasures on earth or in heaven?
