# The Life and Times of Samuel Part one - the Bridge of God 1 Samuel 1:1-2:36

## Samuel was the bridge of God to span a major change

1. **From Judges** - After the time of Joshua -sent by God to deliver the people from a threat. After the threat had passed. *They then served as leaders of the nation.* 

**To Kings** - A chief ruler, one invested with supreme authority over a nation, tribe or country."

2. From Silence - Now in those days messages from the Lord were very rare and visions were quite uncommon 1 Samuel 3:1b

## To Clear Messages - 1 Samuel 3:19-4:1a

In order to bridge this gap God needed a man of truth - a Prophet who spoke for Him. Samuel was a priest and a prophet.

Priest because he was given to Eli to minister before the Lord. Prophet - He was called a prophet twice and a seer 6 times He later established the school of prophets.

## I. The Times

## A. Corrupt Morals

The people had left the true God and were worshiping Ba'al God of Fertility and Thunder - rituals included sacrifice of living babies in fire and sexual activity that included homosexual behavior

## **B.** Compulsory oppression

Because of their sin God allowed the surrounding nations to defeat Israel and occupy their territory

## C. Compromised religion

Eli's sons abused their place of authority and desecrated the sacrifices and lived immoral lives with young women at the Tabernacle. Instead of God - comfort was worshiped

## II. His Birth

## A. Answer to earnest prayer

Hannah was barren and longed for children

She pleaded with God and vowed to give the child to Him

1 Samuel 1:11 And she made this vow: "O LORD of

Heaven's Armies, if you will look upon my sorrow and answer my prayer and give me

a son, then I will give him back to you. He will be yours for his entire lifetime, and as a sign that he has been dedicated to the LORD, his hair will never be cut."

## B. Acknowledged as a gift from God

Hannah returned him to the Lord

Weaned - 3-7 years of age -given to Eli (chief priest)

1 Samuel 1:27-28 I asked the LORD to give me this boy, and he has

granted my request. Now I am giving him to the LORD, and he will belong to the LORD his whole life." And they worshiped the LORD there.

## C. Accepted as a responsibility to fulfill

Hannah came yearly with a new coat

## III. His Preparation

#### A. He belonged to the Lord

His parents had given him to serve the Lord

## B. He was educated by a man of God

Learned to read from the early copies of scripture Learned to worship the Lord

He learned obedience, courage and perseverance

## C. His goal was to please the Lord

1 Samuel 2:26 Meanwhile, the boy Samuel grew taller and grew in favor with the LORD and with the people.

He sought God first and God blessed his life
